MORGAN STATE PICKED TO FINISH FIRST

The defending MEAC champion Morgan State Bears were picked to finish first in the conference's preseason poll for the second consecutive year. Morgan State received 20 first place votes and totaled 476 points to garner the league's top position for the second year in a row. Led by the conference's back-to-back Coach of the Year Todd Bozeman, the Bears were crowned tournament champions and earned their second straight regular season title last year with a 13-3 MEAC record and 23-12 overall mark. MSU recorded several notable wins last season including victories over Marshall (72-67), DePaul (79-75), and Maryland (66-65).

TWO TEAMS SET FOR ESPN'S ANNUAL BRACKETBUSTERS



For the second straight year MEAC men's basketball teams will participate in the annual *BracketBusters* event, a two-day men's college basketball extravaganza pitting potential NCAA Tournament hopefuls against each other. Morgan State, who defeated interstate rival Towson last year, will be joined by South Carolina State, who will make their debut at *BracketBusters* this year. For the fifth straight year, ESPNU will televise five *BracketBusters* games while ESPN2 will televise six contests. The 11 *BracketBusters* matchups will be announced Feb. 1, while game time and network assignments will be announced Feb. 8. The 98-team field will feature 12 teams from the Mid-American and Colonial Athletic; 11 from the Ohio Valley, 10 from the Missouri Valley, Horizon League and Metro Atlantic Athletic; nine from the Western Athletic and Big West; four from the Big South and Southern; three from the America East; two from the MEAC; and one from the Big Sky and Summit League.

MEAC on ESPN

The MEAC announced the 2008-09 basketball television schedule with a thrilling collection of men's and women's competitive matchups on the ESPN family networks. As part of its seven-year partnership with ESPN, the MEAC will highlight nine men's and three women's regular season games. The 2009-10 television schedule tips off with a double-header on Monday, January 11 featuring Hampton and Morgan State men's and women's basketball teams. The 2010 MEAC Championship Tournament will also air on the ESPN networks with the women's championship game scheduled for a taped-delayed broadcast airing on March 14 at 11 a.m. on ESPNU while the men's championship game will broadcast live on ESPN2 beginning at 2 p.m.

THE HONORABLE DELOACH

NSU senior guard Michael Deloach has earned all-tournament honors in the last four tournaments he has competed in including the in-season tournaments at Missouri State, Montana state and the MEAC Tournament (all during 2008-09). He was most recently named to the Basketball Travelers Classic. Deloach was named the 2009-10 MEAC preseason Player of the Year as voted on by the MEAC's sports information directors.

EAGLES UNVEIL NEW PHYSICAL EDUCATION COMPLEX

Coppin State has opened its new home for its men's and women's basketball programs. The Physical Education Complex opened its doors during an interstate matchup against Morgan State on Dec. 5. Though the Eagles were not victorious against the conference's defending champion, 3,189 CSU fans braved difficult weather to cheer for their teams. Coppin State joins Florida A&M University, who also revealed a state-of-the-art basketball facility last year. The Florida A&M Rattlers christened its new \$40 million men's and women's basketball arena last April (2009). FAMU's Multipurpose Center and Teaching Gym seats more than 9,500 fans.

THE BOARD ROOM

Morgan State's Kevin Thompson, the MEAC's current Defensive Player of the Week, leads the conference in rebounds with an average of 12.7. He currently ranks third in the nation in rebounds per game and posted the NCAA single-game high with of 25 boards in the Bears win over Towson. Thompson was named to the Freshman Mid-Major All-America team by Collegeinsider.com last year and has a conference high ninth double-doubles this season, 15 career.

NCAA Highlights

Coppin State, Delaware State, Hampton and North Carolina A&T are currently ranked in the Top 25 of a NCAA statistical category. Coppin State ranks 16th in 3-pt field goal defense (28.1), Hampton is 21st in the nation in steals per game (9.3), Delaware State ranks 10th in personal fouls per game (14.7) and 25th in turnover margin (4.0). North Carolina A&T ranks 11th in 3-pt field goals per game. Several individual players also boast a top 10 national ranking in various NCAA statistical categories. Morgan State's Reggie Holmes is currently ranked 6th in points per game. Kevin Thompson also of Morgan State currently ranks 3rd in rebounds per game and 2nd in double-doubles. Jay Threatt of Delaware State ranks 5th in steals per game.

Bozeman Named National Mid-Major Coach of the Year

Morgan State's Todd Bozeman was named the National Mid-Major Coach of the Year voted on by a 20-member selection panel including current and former head coaches. He also earned his second consecutive MEAC Coach of the Year honor after guiding the Bears to their first back-to-back regular season title and the first in school history to guide his team to back-to-back post season tournaments, including the school's first appearance in the NIT and the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament. The Bears completed the 2008-09 season with a 13-3 conference record, 23-12 overall mark.

Morgan State players will wear a number 4 patch on their jerseys this season and have dedicated the season to Anthony Anderson, a 6-10 redshirt freshman from St. Charles, Md. who was expected to be coming off the bench this season. Anderson, who was diagnosed with Leukemia in October, is currently undergoing chemotherapy at Johns Hopkins Hospital.
