PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Calvin Thompson (Howard) averaged 24 points, 8.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists in two conference wins last week. He recorded a double-double of 15 points and 12 rebounds in 31 minutes in a 59-53 win against Coppin State. He followed that performance with a career-high 33 points while also grabbing seven rebounds in a 82-77 win against North Carolina A&T. In the two wins, Thompson shot 50-percent (13-of-26) from the field, connected on 4-of-8 from 3-point range and 85 percent (18-of-21) from the free-throw line.

Co-ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Dadrian Collins (Howard) averaged 16.5 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 2.0 steals in two conference victories over Coppin State and North Carolina A&T. He recorded 18 points, shooting 7-of-16 from the floor, against the CSU Eagles.

DeWayne Jackson (Morgan State) averaged 14.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, 1.5 steals and 1.0 blocked shots in two conference victories over Hampton and S.C. State. He scored a game-high 19 points, connecting on 5-of-10 (50-percent) from the floor with five rebounds and two steals in 28 minutes of play.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Kevin Thompson (Morgan State) collected his 11th double-double rebounding game of the season finishing with 20 boards along with 14 points and two blocks in a win over S.C. State. He also hauled down a game-high nine boards with 11 points earlier last week against Hampton.

MORGAN STATE PICKED TO FINISH FIRST

The defending MEAC champion Morgan State Bears were picked to finish first in the conference's preseason poll for the second consecutive year. Morgan State received 20 first place votes and totaled 476 points to garner the league's top position for the second year in a row. Led by the conference's back-to-back Coach of the Year Todd Bozeman, the Bears were crowned tournament champions and earned their second straight regular season title last year with a 13-3 MEAC record and 23-12 overall mark. MSU recorded several notable wins last season including victories over Marshall (72-67), DePaul (79-75), and Maryland (66-65).

TWO TEAMS SET FOR ESPN'S ANNUAL BRACKETBUSTERS



For the second straight year MEAC men's basketball teams will participate in the annual *BracketBusters* event, a two-day men's college basketball extravaganza pitting potential NCAA Tournament hopefuls against each other. Morgan State, who defeated interstate rival Towson last year, will be joined by South Carolina State, who will make their debut at *BracketBusters* this year. For the fifth straight year, ESPNU will televise five *BracketBusters* games while ESPN2 will televise six contests. The 11 *BracketBusters* matchups will be announced Feb. 1, while game time and network assignments will be announced Feb. 8. The 98-team field will feature 12 teams from the Mid-American and Colonial Athletic; 11 from the Ohio Valley, 10 from the Missouri Valley, Horizon League and Metro Atlantic Athletic; nine from the Western Athletic and Big West; four from the Big South and Southern; three from the America East; two from the MEAC; and one from the Big Sky and Summit League.

MEAC on ESPN

The MEAC announced the 2008-09 basketball television schedule with a thrilling collection of men's and women's competitive matchups on the ESPN family networks. As part of its seven-year partnership with ESPN, the MEAC will highlight nine men's and three women's regular season games. The 2009-10 television schedule tips off with a double-header on Monday, January 11 featuring Hampton and Morgan State men's and women's basketball teams. The 2010 MEAC Championship Tournament will also air on the ESPN networks with the women's championship game scheduled for a taped-delayed broadcast airing on March 14 at 11 a.m. on ESPNU while the men's championship game will broadcast live on ESPN2 beginning at 2 p.m.

THE HONORABLE DELOACH

NSU senior guard Michael DeLoach has earned all-tournament honors in the last four tournaments he has competed in including the in-season tournaments at Missouri State, Montana state and the MEAC Tournament (all during 2008-09). He was most recently named to the Basketball Travelers Classic. DeLoach was named the 2009-10 MEAC preseason Player of the Year as voted on by the MEAC's sports information directors.

EAGLES UNVEIL NEW PHYSICAL EDUCATION COMPLEX

Coppin State has opened its new home for its men's and women's basketball programs. The Physical Education Complex opened its doors during an interstate matchup against Morgan State on Dec. 5. Though the Eagles were not victorious against the conference's defending champion, 3,189 CSU fans braved difficult weather to cheer for their teams. Coppin State joins Florida A&M University, who also revealed a state-of-the-art basketball facility last year. The Florida A&M Rattlers christened its new \$40 million men's and women's basketball arena last April (2009). FAMU's Multipurpose Center and Teaching Gym seats more than 9,500 fans.

THE BOARD ROOM

Morgan State's Kevin Thompson, the MEAC's current Defensive Player of the Week, leads the conference in rebounds with an average of 12.6. He currently ranks fourth in the nation in rebounds per game and posted the NCAA single-game high with of 25 boards in the Bears win over Towson. Thompson was named to the Freshman Mid-Major All-America team by Collegeinsider.com last year and has a conference high nine double-doubles this season, 15 career.

The Hornets currently boast a 3-1 conference record and 8-7 mark overall. DSU defeated Florida A&M 64-57 in their last outing. The Eagles are stumbling down a MEAC losing skid of four games and will look to snap an eight-game losing streak with a win over the Hornets. The telecast is the fourth MEAC conference TV game on the ESPN family networks. The Howard Bison defeated the Norfolk State Spartans, 82-77, in the last televised game on Jan. 18.

Carter closes in on 200 while Reed and Collins Chase 100th Career Victory

Tim Carter of South Carolina State is two games away from his 200th career victory. Carter took over the Bulldogs coaching staff at the start of the 2007-08 season. Carter is no stranger to winning, prior to joining the Bulldogs he recorded 160 wins for the University of Texas-San Antonio (1995-2006) and is currently the Roadrunners all-time winningest coach.
