PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Reggie Holmes (Morgan State) averaged 25.0 points in two conference wins last week for the league-leading MSU Bears. Against Winston-Salem State Holmes recorded 22 points, shooting 6-of-13 from the field and knocked down 9-of-11 from the charity stripe. He followed that performance with 28 points against Delaware State, connecting on 4-of-9 shots from field. He also registered 18-of-20 free-throws against the Hornets, grabbed seven rebounds and dished out one assist.

Co-ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Dadrian Collins (Howard) averaged 17.5 points and 6.5 rebounds to assist the Bison to a 1-1 mark last week. Collins scored 21 points and pulled down eight rebounds with two assists and one blocked shot in a win over Norfolk State. He also recorded 14 points, shooting 4-of-8 from long range, with five rebounds in 29 minutes against Florida A&M. For the week Collins shot 52-percent from the field (13-of-25) and 47-percent from beyond the arc (8-of-17) for the Bison.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Kevin Thompson (Morgan State) recorded his 12th double-double of the season with 10 boards along with 12 points against Winston-Salem State. He also posted three blocks and one steal in the win. In addition, Thompson grabbed seven rebounds in the Bears win over Delaware State. Thompson has earned the MEAC's Defensive Player of the Week honor six times this season including the last three weeks.

MORGAN STATE PICKED TO FINISH FIRST

The defending MEAC champion Morgan State Bears were picked to finish first in the conference's preseason poll for the second consecutive year. Morgan State received 20 first place votes and totaled 476 points to garner the league's top position for the second year in a row. Led by the conference's back-to-back Coach of the Year Todd Bozeman, the Bears were crowned tournament champions and earned their second straight regular season title last year with a 13-3 MEAC record and 23-12 overall mark. MSU recorded several notable wins last season including victories over Marshall (72-67), DePaul (79-75), and Maryland (66-65).

TWO TEAMS SET FOR ESPN'S ANNUAL BRACKETBUSTERS



For the second straight year MEAC men's basketball teams will participate in the annual *BracketBusters* event, a two-day men's college basketball extravaganza pitting potential NCAA Tournament hopefuls against each other. Morgan State, who defeated interstate rival Towson last year, will be joined by South Carolina State, who will make their debut at *BracketBusters* this year. For the fifth straight year, ESPNU will televise five *BracketBusters* games while ESPN2 will televise six contests. The 11 *BracketBusters* matchups will be announced Feb. 1, while game time and network assignments will be announced Feb. 8. The 98-team field will feature 12 teams from the Mid-American and Colonial Athletic; 11 from the Ohio Valley, 10 from the Missouri Valley, Horizon League and Metro Atlantic Athletic; nine from the Western Athletic and Big West; four from the Big South and Southern; three from the America East; two from the MEAC; and one from the Big Sky and Summit League.

MEAC on ESPN

The MEAC announced the 2008-09 basketball television schedule with a thrilling collection of men's and women's competitive matchups on the ESPN family networks. As part of its seven-year partnership with ESPN, the MEAC will highlight nine men's and three women's regular season games. The 2009-10 television schedule tips off with a double-header on Monday, January 11 featuring Hampton and Morgan State men's and women's basketball teams. The 2010 MEAC Championship Tournament will also air on the ESPN networks with the women's championship game scheduled for a taped-delayed broadcast airing on March 14 at 11 a.m. on ESPNU while the men's championship game will broadcast live on ESPN2 beginning at 2 p.m.

THE HONORABLE DELOACH

NSU senior guard Michael DeLoach has earned all-tournament honors in the last four tournaments he has competed in including the in-season tournaments at Missouri State, Montana state and the MEAC Tournament (all during 2008-09). He was most recently named to the Basketball Travelers Classic. DeLoach was named the 2009-10 MEAC preseason Player of the Year as voted on by the MEAC's sports information directors.

EAGLES UNVEIL NEW PHYSICAL EDUCATION COMPLEX

Coppin State has opened its new home for its men's and women's basketball programs. The Physical Education Complex opened its doors during an interstate matchup against Morgan State on Dec. 5. Though the Eagles were not victorious against the conference's defending champion, 3,189 CSU fans braved difficult weather to cheer for their teams. Coppin State joins Florida A&M University, who also revealed a state-of-the-art basketball facility last year. The Florida A&M Rattlers christened its new \$40 million men's and women's basketball arena last April (2009). FAMU's Multipurpose Center and Teaching Gym seats more than 9,500 fans.

THE BOARD ROOM

Morgan State's Kevin Thompson, the MEAC's current Defensive Player of the Week, leads the conference in rebounds with an average of 12.3. He currently ranks fourth in the nation in rebounds per game and posted the NCAA single-game high with of 25 boards in the Bears win over Towson. Thompson was named to the Freshman Mid-Major All-America team by Collegeinsider.com last year and has a conference high nine double-doubles this season, 15 career.

Bozeman Named National Mid-Major Coach of the Year

Morgan State's Todd Bozmen was named the National Mid-Major Coach of the Year voted on by a 20-member selection panel including current and former head coaches. He also earned his second consecutive MEAC Coach of the Year honor after guiding the Bears to their first back-to-back regular season title and the first in school history to guide his team to back-to-back post season tournaments, including the school's first appearance in the NIT and the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament. Carter closes in on 200 while Reed and Collins Chase 100th Career Victory

Tim Carter of South Carolina State is two games away from his 200th career victory. Carter took over the Bulldogs coaching staff at the start of the 2007-08 season. Reed is currently boasting a 99-145 overall record in his seven year career. WSSU's Collins is five games shy of his 100th career victory with a 96-130 record in eight years.

The Delaware State Hornets are the best team in the MEAC with keeping their hands off of opposing teams. DSU averages just 14.1 personal fouls per game, 3rd best of 334 NCAA Division I ranked teams. Tough defense is not a stretch for the Hornets who also rank 18th in the NCAA in scoring defense, allowing just 59.6 points per game.

The Morgan State Bears earned the 2009 MEAC Tournament title and the conference's automatic berth to the NCAA Division I Tournament.
