PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Michael Deloach (Norfolk State) averaged 17.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 1.5 steals as he led the Spartans to a pair of victories over Howard and Winston-Salem State and extend their win streak to three. Deloach recorded 16 points, seven rebounds, four assists and one steal against the Bison. He connected on 6-of-11 shots for 18 points with five assists and two steals in the win over Winston-Salem State.

ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Marques Oliver (Delaware State) combined for 24 points, 11 rebounds, five blocks, one assist and one steal to aide the Hornets to a 1-1 mark last week. He recorded a dozen points, shooting 5-of-7 from the field, with seven rebounds, three blocks, one steal and one assist in a win over Florida A&M. He also recorded 12 points, with four rebounds and two blocks in a loss to Morgan State.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Tyler Hines (Maryland E. Shore) led the Hawks to a homecoming victory over Coppin State as he pulled down a game-high 13 rebounds in the 66-52 win. He posted 18 rebounds, one block and one steal to aid the Hawks to a 2-0 MEAC mark last week.

MORGAN STATE PICKED TO FINISH FIRST

The defending MEAC champion Morgan State Bears were picked to finish first in the conference's preseason poll for the second consecutive year. Morgan State received 20 first place votes and totaled 476 points to garner the league's top position for the second year in a row. Led by the conference's back-to-back Coach of the Year Todd Bozeman, the Bears were crowned tournament champions and earned their second straight regular season title last year with a 13-3 MEAC record and 23-12 overall mark. MSU recorded several notable wins last season including victories over Marshall (72-67), DePaul (79-75), and Maryland (66-65).

TWO TEAMS COMPETE IN ANNUAL BRACKETBUSTERS

Two MEAC men's basketball teams participated in the *2010 BracketBusters*. The defending champion Morgan State Bears faced the Murray State Racers in a televised game on ESPNU on Saturday, Feb. 20 on ESPNU. The Bears came up short as they were defeated by the Racers 75-66. The Bears are currently 1-1 in BracketBuster play. South Carolina State loss to Georgia State, 67-52, in a non-televised matchup, also on Feb. 20, The *BracketBusters* concept, named because of the success of participating teams from these conferences in NCAA Tournament play through the years, provides programs with an opportunity to play top non-conference opponents roughly three weeks before Selection Sunday. Each conference selects its participating teams before the season, and the matchups for the event are determined by ESPN in conjunction with the conferences.

MEAC on ESPN

The MEAC announced the 2009-10 basketball television schedule with a thrilling collection of men's and women's competitive matchups on the ESPN family networks. As part of its seven-year partnership with ESPN, the MEAC will highlight nine men's and three women's regular season games. The 2009-10 television schedule tips off with a double-header on Monday, January 11 featuring Hampton and Morgan State men's and women's basketball teams. The 2010 MEAC Championship Tournament will also air on the ESPN networks with the women's championship game scheduled for a taped-delayed broadcast airing on March 14 at 11 a.m. on ESPNU while the men's championship game will broadcast live on ESPN2 beginning at 2 p.m.

THE HONORABLE DELOACH

NSU senior guard Michael Deloach has earned all-tournament honors in the last four tournaments he has competed in including the in-season tournaments at Missouri State, Montana State and the MEAC Tournament (all during 2008-09). He was most recently named to the Basketball Travelers Classic. Deloach was named the 2009-10 MEAC preseason Player of the Year as voted on by the MEAC's sports information directors.



EAGLES UNVEIL NEW PHYSICAL EDUCATION COMPLEX

Coppin State has opened its new home for its men's and women's basketball programs. The Physical Education Complex opened its doors during an interstate matchup against Morgan State on Dec. 5. Though the Eagles were not victorious against the conference's defending champion, 3,189 CSU fans braved difficult weather to cheer for their teams. Coppin State joins Florida A&M University, who also revealed a state-of-the-art basketball facility last year. The Florida A&M Rattlers christened its new \$40 million men's and women's basketball arena last April (2009). FAMU's Multipurpose Center and Teaching Gym seats more than 9,500 fans.

THE BOARD ROOM

Morgan State's Kevin Thompson, a seven time MEAC Defensive Player of the Week recipient this season, leads the conference in rebounds with an average of 11.6. He currently ranks third in the nation in rebounds per game and posted the NCAA single-game high with of 25 boards in the Bears win over Towson. Thompson was named to the Freshman Mid-Major All-America team by Collegeinsider.com last year and has a conference high 18 double-doubles this season, fourth best in the NCAA.

NCAA Highlights

Coppin State, Delaware State and North Carolina A&T are currently ranked in the Top 25 of an NCAA statistical category. Coppin State ranks 13th in 3-point field goal defense with an average of 28.7 and 25th in free-throw percentage (74.0 avg/g). Delaware State ranks 3rd in turnover margin (5.7), 11th in personal fouls (15.1 avg/g), 9th in scoring defense (59.3 avg/g), and 20th in turnovers per game (11.3). The North Carolina A&T Aggies rank 20th in 3-point field goals per game (8.3 avg/g). Several individual players also boast a top 10 national ranking in various NCAA statistical categories. Kevin Thompson of Morgan State currently ranks 4th in rebounds per game (11.6 rpg) and 4th in double-doubles (18). Jay Threat of Delaware State ranks 8th in steals per game (2.8 avg/g).

Bozeman Named National Mid-Major Coach of the Year

Morgan State's Todd Bozmen was named the National Mid-Major Coach of the Year voted on by a 20-member selection panel including current and former head coaches. He also earned his second consecutive MEAC Coach of the Year honor after guiding the Bears to their first back-to-back regular season title and the first in school history to guide his team to back-to-back post season tournaments, including the school's first appearance in the NIT and the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Tournament. The Bears completed the 2008-09 season with a 13-3 conference record, 23-12 overall mark.
