FAMU Finishes MEAC 9–1: The Rattlers completed their conference season with a win over 6–1, victory over Bethune–Cookman on Saturday. Sithole Thabade won the lone singles match for B–CC. Thabade defeated Pfungwa Mahefu at the No. 1 position (6–2, 2–6, 7–5). Zurab Zhvania (No. 2), Frank Green (No. 3), Clifford Malivert (No. 4), Vassil Zahariev (No. 5) and Jarrel Williams (No. 6) all won their matches in straight sets for FAMU. The teams of Green/Malivert and Williams/Zahariev won their matches in doubles action to receive the doubles point.

Hampton's Chang Drops 2 in a Row: Seo–Jae Chang lost to Howard's Kenneth Brown (6–2, 6–4) and Georgia State's Jaime Rodriguez (6–4, 6–3) last week ending his 10 match win streak. The Pirates lost both matches, 4–3 to the Bison and 6–0 to the Panthers. Fernando Uehara (No. 3) earned a win over Howard's Jibade Thomas improving to

10–4. Jason Lambert (No. 4) and Joao Sacomandi also recorded victories versus Howard.

Eagles defeat Bears in Local

Matchup: Coppin State squeaked by Morgan State, 4–3 last Thursday. The Eagles picked up points from their top three players and took two of three doubles matches. Florin Celea (No. 1), Joseph Reynolds (No. 2) and Parker Scott (No. 3) won in singles action, while the teams of Parker/Reynolds and Jones/Holcomb earn wins in doubles competition.

Bears Win Two Straight: Morgan State defeated UMES, 7–0 on Tuesday and Robert Morris, 4–2 Sunday as they ended a seven–game losing skid. Marcus Ngbea (No. 1), Michael Harper (No. 4), Dia Campbell (No. 5) and Matthew Townes all recorded victories in the win over RMU.

Hornets Go 1–1: Catalin Popescu (No. 1), James Lapere (No. 2), Liston Fahie (No. 3) and Adae Amoaka (No. 6)

were victorious in Delaware State's 5–2 win over Maryland–Eastern Shore. The teams of Lapere/Popescu and Liston/Amoaka both won in doubles competition. DSU lost to Hampton 7–0 last week.

N.C. A&T's Kirkland/Hawley Improve to 9–2: Vitas Hawley and Jerome Kirkland won their ninth match of the season, as they defeated Elon's duo of Kyle Smialek and John Garnett 8–2 at No. 3 doubles. The Aggies would lose the contest, 5–2 winning another doubles from Damon Martin and Porter Myrick. Myrick also picked up a singles win at No. 4.

Howard Moves Into 4th: The Bison moved into fourth place in the MEAC with their win over Hampton last Friday. Kenneth Brown (No. 1) gave Hampton's Seo–Jae Chang his first conference loss of the season. Brandon Smith (No. 2) and Neilabh Avasthi (No. 6) recorded wins in singles action. Smith and Brown won at No. 2 doubles and Avasthi and Othmane Garma won at No. 3 doubles.

MEAC Notes

Hampton Improves to 7–1 in Conference: The Lady Pirates improved to 7–1 in the MEAC with wins over Delaware State and Howard last week. Hampton defeated both opponents 7–0. In non-conference action Kristyna Pesatova (No. 1), and Katerina Jiskrova earned victories in a 4–3 loss to Georgia State on Sunday. Pesatova is now 14–2 on the season, while Jiskrova is 13–2. Hampton earned the doubles point as Pesatova/Jiskrova won at the number one position and the duo of Lucia Kapisinka/Jana Korycankova were victorious at No. 3 doubles.

Lady Bears Win Three In a Row: Morgan State has won three consecutive matches improving their record to 4–14. MSU started the streak with a hard fought, 4–3 victory on Coppin State last Thursday. On Sunday they defeated Robert Morris, 5–1 and continued their success with a, 7–0 sweep over UMES. Walaa Elsir (No. 2),

Renea Alleyne (No.4), Aidah Rasheed (No. 5), and Kemi Osunsan (No. 6) all went 3–0 in the three matches played.

Howard Drops Close Match to Georgetown: Kristen Harris, Cecelia Townes and Blancada Marion all recorded wins in the Lady Bison’s 4–3 loss to local rival Georgetown on Tuesday. Harris defeated Stephanie Cohen at the No. 1 position (6–7 (4), 1–6), while Townes won at the No. 5 position against Sana Malouf (4–6, 6–4, 3–6). Blancada earned a tough fought victory over Eileen Boyle in a marathon match, 7–5, 6–7 (10), 5–10.

B–CC Streak Ended: The Lady Wildcats four match win streak came to a halt to Jacksonville last Wednesday. B–CC received victories from Olra Ruislova at No. 1 and Martina Strussova at No. 3 in the 5–2 loss. Ruislova won in straight sets over Emese Sulyos (6–4, 6–2) and

Strussova defeated Nisrine Hajbane (3–6, 6–3, 7–5). The pair also recorded their 14th doubles victory winning 8–4 over Lena Willi and Nisrine Hajbane at the No. 1 doubles.

Lady Aggies Blanked by Elon: North Carolina A&T were shutout 7–0, against Elon on Tuesday. The Lady Aggies lost all six singles matches and all three doubles matches.

Lady Hornets Go 1–1 For the Week: Delaware State defeated UMES 5–2 on Friday and lost to Hampton 7–0 last Wednesday. Janine Jacob (No. 1), Carlene Young (No. 2), Erika Greene (No. 3), Jennifer Dailey (No. 4), the top four players for DSU, all defeated their opponents in straight sets. Maryland–Eastner Shore picked up points with victories by Yamanda Dorsey and Sashonna Leak.
